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Bane Canyon Entrance of Chino Hills State Park re-opens for temporary access

The Bane Canyon entrance of Chino Hills State Park located at 4721 Sapphire Road in the City of Chino Hills has been closed for road construction since August 2011. Due to problems with the contractor, the work on the road has stopped. California State Parks is working diligently to continue with the planned entrance road improvements, and in the meantime Bane Canyon Road remains an inactive construction site. Due to this prolonged inactivity, local park staff has sought for a temporary re-opening of this popular park entrance to provide access to the trails within Chino Hills State Park.

Therefore, as of **Saturday May 25, 2013 at 8am**, temporary access will be allowed for pedestrians, bicyclists, and equestrians until further notice. Vehicles are not permitted to enter and the campground, group camp, horse camp and equestrian staging area remains closed. Park visitors are warned they are entering an inactive construction site. Park visitors must remain on the designated trail at all times. When construction becomes active, the area will be closed again. The area will be signed accordingly.

Chino Hills State Park Hours of operation are 8am-7pm April to September and 8am-5pm October to March
